Examination with Model

A full-size model was made on site to study delicate shapes that were difficult to see on

the blueprints. The shape of the plaster to be applied as a finish over the roof tiles was determined by creating multiple patterns and comparing them with old photographs. At the same time, experiments were conducted to examine whether the building could drain well without water entering the structure when it rained.
