

Much Talked about Kikuchi Kan, Budding Author!

Kikuchi Kan had many obstacles to overcome before he became a popular writer. He started to write stories in his school days. He joined the newspaper company, Jiji Shimpō, after graduating from university. He continued writing literary works while working as a journalist, though he was often swamped with hard work. Especially, it was difficult for him to cover a story when his friends were in grief for the death of the great novelist whom he respected, Natsume Soseki. Nonetheless, he worked diligently and kept on writing stories.

In June 1918, Kan published “Diary of an Unknown Writer” in *Chuokoron*, which is a famous literary magazine. What it meant was he acquired a place among the great writers of Japan.

Subsequently, Kikuchi Kan left Jiji Shimpō and concentrated on his literary work. He then published “Madame Pearl”. This story of love and revenge by the beautiful heroine, Ruriko, was a big hit and made him a popular writer in no time.
