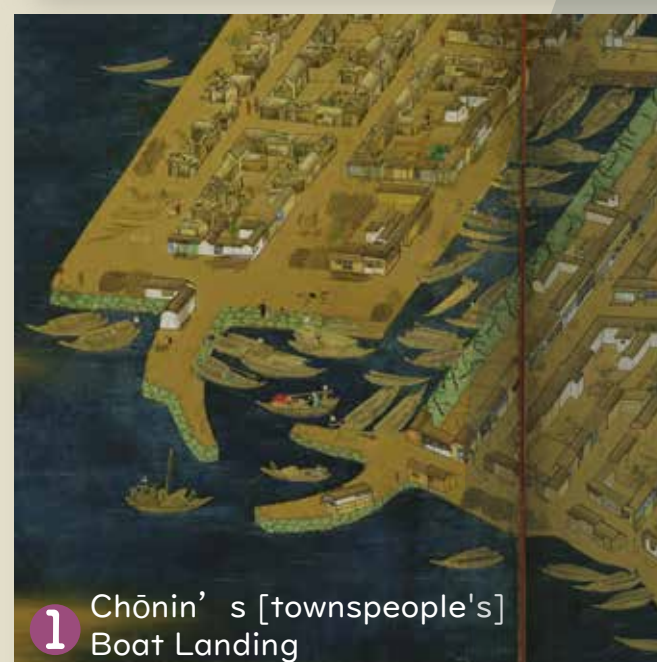
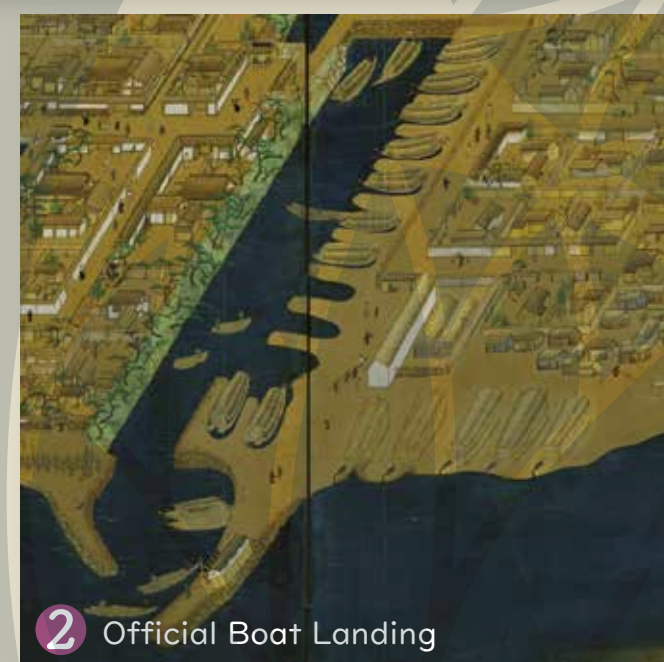


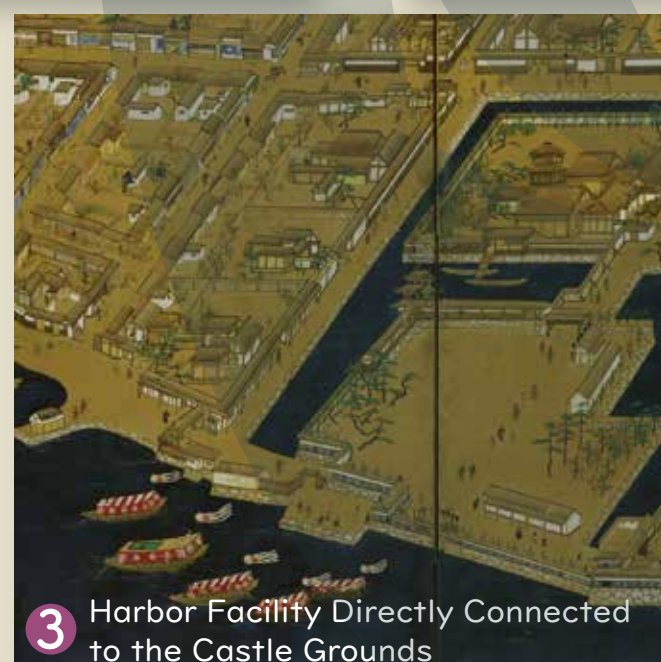

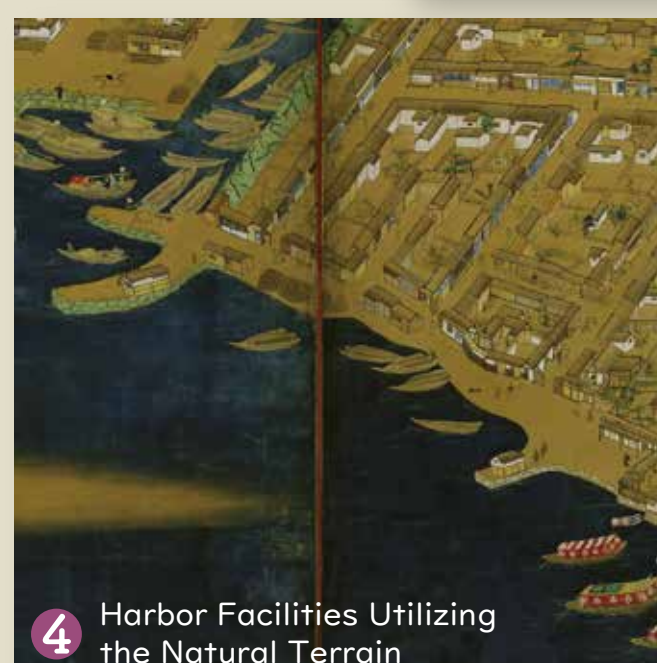
1 Chōnin's [townspeople's] Boat Landing



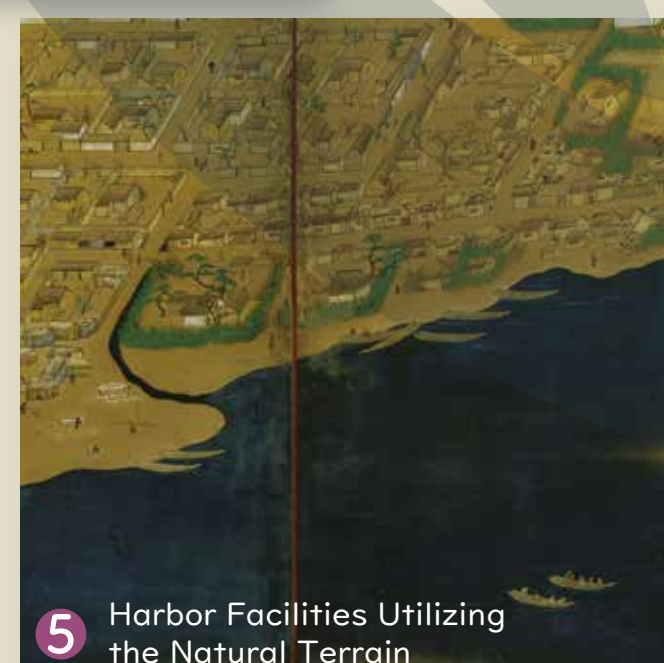
2 Official Boat Landing

“Takamatsu jōka-zu byōbu” (Folding Screen of the Castle Town of Takamatsu) depicts the existence of several port facilities under Takamatsu Castle.

In addition to the boat entrances (1 & 2) on the east and west sides of the castle, there are also a port facility (3) that connects the castle directly to the sea. There were also harbor facilities (4 & 5) that made use of the topography of the beach. Another major feature of Takamatsu Castle, which is a seaside castle, is that it has built a variety of ports to suit different uses and purposes.
