The most distinctive feature of Takamatsu Castle's Tenshu is the “nanban zukuri” architectural style, in which the top floor overhangs outward. This structure is thought to have been modeled after Kokura Castle, and there are other similar examples such as Iwakuni Castle. The Tenshu alone, excluding the stonewalls, was towering high even by national standards and was the tallest on the island of Shikoku.
